



## ***Site Supervisor***

Location: Woodlawn Mine Tarago NSW

Work type: Permanent Site-based role

**Heron Resources Limited** is a mining and exploration company, with head office in Sydney. Heron is a public company listed on both the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX:HRR) and the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSX:HER). The company is currently developing its Woodlawn Zinc-Copper Project with construction underway.

The Woodlawn Zinc-Copper Project is located at the Woodlawn Mine site located 40 kilometres south of Goulburn and 220 kilometres southwest of Sydney in NSW. The site is well serviced by infrastructure, as well as road (Federal Highway), train transport between Canberra and Sydney, and access to Canberra airport. The project is located near Tarago village, in the NSW southern tablelands.

The project comprises two significant poly-metallic resources from both Underground and Tailings. Construction of a new underground mine commenced in November 2017, and the existing Tailings Dams are planned to be re-processed. Construction of the Process Plant commenced in September 2017, and commissioning scheduled in December 2018 to January 2019.

Heron is currently building the site team to commission and operate the Process Plant. The team will come together in through 2018, and develop goals, strategies and processes to implement during the commissioning and operating phases of the project. The project is new, exciting, multi-faceted, and provides a wide exposure to different processes that are included in the design.

As part of the management team for the Process Plant, application for the new position of Site Supervisor is sought, to start work in early 2018.

Reporting to the Process Manager, the Site Supervisor will be responsible for supervising an existing team (contractors) in the day to day establishment of site services, in preparation for Process Plant commissioning in December 2018. The role will involve establishing borefield and site water services, tailings dam management, and other tasks associated with assisting the construction contractors. The role will develop as construction progresses through 2018. The role is an exciting opportunity to be an “early starter” on the Woodlawn project, and be part of the development of the teams, systems and procedures that will progress during 2018. It is envisaged that the role will progress into an important shift supervisory position in the Process Plant as the final operating crews are established in readiness for commissioning.

The operation will be technically challenging, including crushing, ball milling, IsaMill, four vertical regrind mills, four stages of flotation, filtration, water treatment, tailings mining, paste plant, and concentrate handling. The incumbent will need prior experience in base metal flotation processing, and preferred extensive experience in supervision of operation crews.

Exposure to similar operations will be highly regarded for this role.
