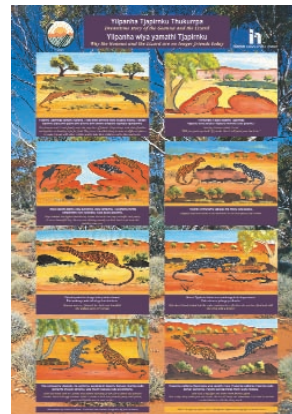
Heron is very proud to be involved with a project that breaks down the cultural barriers and helps both indigenous and non-indigenous Australians to learn about our ancient culture.
